HAZARDOUS WASTE

Anything labeled hazardous under federal, state, or local law.



ASBESTOS-CONTAINING **MATERIALS**



Often found in old brakes. insulation, floor tiles, and electrical parts.



Transformers, capacitors, light ballasts with PCBs.

APPLIANCES W/ REFRIGERANTS (CFCs)

Fridges, A/C units-okay only if CFCs* are removed or preapproved.



ELECTRONICS

Computers, monitors, TVs, fax machines, printers, etc.




CYLINDERS/ **COMPRESSED GAS**



Includes propane bottles unless de-valved or cut in half.

SEALED CONTAINERS





BATTERIES

Lead-acid, lithium-ion, NiCad, rechargeable, etc.





Gas tanks, diesel tanks, solvents, oils, paints, kerosene, capacitors, varnishes







DIRTY DRUMS/TANKS /CONTAINERS

Must be 100% clean. No oil, grease, cleaner, or chemical residue.

OILY / GREASY MATERIALS



Engines, transmissions, oil filters, fuel tanks, hydraulic systems with hydrocarbons.

RADIOACTIVE **MATERIALS**



Pipes, gauges, or machines containing radioactive components.



Thermostats, switches (nonauto), and devices with mercury.


EXPLOSIVE MATERIALS

Fireworks, ammo, or anything that goes boom.

NON-**RECYCLABLE** JUNK



Garbage, dirt, concrete, and trash that's just not metal.
